CHAIRMAN'S NOTES 2024

Welcome to the Wilden Industrial Estates Cricket League for 2024. It's nice to be able to report a continuingly healthy League. We welcome a new team, Kinver CC, to our ranks and a second team from Oldswinford making a total of 19 teams taking a full part this year.

Success can bring its own problems and your committee has wrestled with the issue of how to fit 19 teams into one League structure. A survey of clubs' wishes over the winter suggested that Cup competitions were still valued, so we have produced a fixtures list that includes a good sprinkling of them.

A new FA Cup style knock-out Cup, sponsored by Howard Burley, will be introduced this year, and for teams eliminated in the first round there will be another new knockout competition sponsored by Nic Harvey. Both will follow standard League rules.

The League structure will be in 3 divisions, the Kelvin Lee Premier division (7 teams), the Folkes Worton Championship division (6 teams) and the Conference division (6 teams). League fixtures will conclude by the end of July, leaving room for our popular short-form Cups, the Audrey Burley 10x10 and the Dave Stubley W60, during the darker, August evenings. As last year, teams were given the opportunity to choose which of these Cups they preferred.

We are always grateful to clubs who offer their grounds for our Cup finals. If your club would like to host a final this year, and hence support the League, please get in touch with the committee.

During the lockdown years we relaxed our rules on General Meeting attendance. Please note that this year we will be strictly applying our rules on attendance and implementing penalties for those clubs who are not represented at meetings. It is important that there is good communication between you, the clubs, and your elected committee. Face-to-face meetings are still the best way of doing this and of distributing handbooks and team sheets etc.

We held a very enjoyable AGM and Presentation evening last November with our special guest, first class Glamorgan player Zain ul Hassan, telling us about his cricketing life, handing out trophies and awards and chatting with club representatives. We are grateful to Zain for giving his time freely and we wish him well in his career.

Once again our games will be umpired by qualified officials who continue to make themselves available to our League. We are grateful to them and encourage all teams to support them, treat them with respect and plan ahead so that you can pay them promptly on the day. Umpire appointments will be co-ordinated by our League appointments secretary who should be your first port of call if you have any queries about your appointed umpire.

In 2026 the League will be 50 years old. How can we best mark the occasion? Please put your thinking caps on and see what you can come up with.

We are indebted to Wilden Industrial Estates and all our sponsors for their support which enables us to function and to keep costs down for you, our clubs. If you know of an individual or an organisation who would like to sponsor the League please get in touch with me.

I wish you all a successful and enjoyable season.

PLAYERS, RESULTS AND AVERAGES

Player Eligibility

The League welcomes players of all standards.

Submit your teams by filling in and signing the team sheet before the game.

Once a player appears for your club they are signed to you for the season.

You should indicate a new signing in the correct column on the team sheet

Substitute fielders do not need to be signed players.

The home captain should retain the team sheet after the game and forward to the League committee at the next General Meeting. This enables confirmation of signed players alongside correct Play Cricket entries. The League may request to see cards in case of eligibility queries.

Players wishing to transfer to another club must apply to the League.

No transfers are allowed after the June General Meeting each year.

All players MUST be covered by insurance.

Cup Matches: No new signings permitted in Semi Finals or Finals

Results

Use of the Play-Cricket scoring app is recommended for uploading scores direct to the website.

The result and summary of the game (e.g. 150 for 4) must be entered on Play-Cricket by the home team by the Friday after the game.

Full score cards are requested to be entered on to Play Cricket by the following Tuesday.

League positions will be published on the website via play-cricket subject to ratification.

Averages

Averages will be calculated from scores submitted to Play-Cricket or may be submitted at the September General Meeting.

LEAGUE RULES 2024

MCC Laws of Cricket 2017 code (3rd Edition – 2022) apply. The following pages are a summary of the additional League rules. Where a rule number is referenced, please consult the full League rules, a copy of which can be found at:

www.wildencricket.com/rules.

Umpire liability/team sheet to be completed accurately and handed to the umpire before the game starts.

All matches to start at 6.30pm except in April when matches should begin at 6:15pm due to light.

Each innings shall consist of at least 6 and no more than 12 eight ball overs.

Each bowler limited to a maximum of 3 overs each.

Minimum of 5 bowlers must be used during the innings.

After 7.00pm (6:45pm in April) or 6 overs no player may join a match except as a sub.

All games to have a fielding circle.

A minimum of **half the team** must be within the circle **at all times**.

Wides, no-balls, beamers and bouncers:

Balls down leg side are “wide”.

In The Conference only, wides are awarded 2 runs and NOT rebowled, except in the last over of each innings when normal laws apply (1 run and rebowled).

Bouncers above head height are “no-ball”.

No more than one ball per batsman per over above shoulder height

Beamers are “no-ball” regardless of the speed of delivery

Intimidatory bowling may be subject to disciplinary action.

Umpire discretion permitted with beamers and balls bouncing more than once.

From 2024 all “no-balls” result in a **Free Hit**.

Forfeited games: Offending teams will be penalised except where all games are subsequently washed out.

Late starts: Umpires deduct one over every 4 minutes from the offending team (rule 47)

Weather delay: Umpires deduct one over per innings every 8 mins delay (rule 48)

Weather break: No overs can be deducted in the second innings, which must be completed in full or game abandoned (rule 48)

Points:	Win	4 points
	Tie	2 points each
	Abandoned match	2 points each
	Loss	0 points

PLAYING CONDITIONS 2024

- All Fixtures are to be played as stated in this handbook.
- Away clubs should come prepared for both grass or artificial wickets.
- No spikes on artificial wickets.
- Fielding circles should be marked as described in League rule 56.
- Pink or other high visibility balls (not white) are mandatory.
- Players should be suitably attired for cricket.
- Coloured club kit is permitted with committee permission.

Ground unavailable?

- Play at another ground, reverse the fixture, or rearrange within 6 days and notify the league.
- Final resort: forfeit the game (but beware of the sanctions).

Ground, Weather & Light guidelines

- On the day of the game the Home Groundsman must be the initial adjudicator as to the fitness of the ground.
- Before play begins both Captains should agree on the fitness of the ground and length of the game, in consultation with the umpires.
- Umpires have the final say once play begins
- If weather or light deteriorates the game may be abandoned by the umpires.
- Home clubs should do everything they can to GET THE GAME ON.
- Playing of "double headers" is not permitted.

Game off?

- Notify away team and umpires straight away.
- Report abandoned games on PlayCricket.
- League games cannot be re-arranged due weather.
- Cup games can be re-arranged only ONCE to avoid fixture congestion.
- Teams failing to turn up will incur penalties and fines.

Cup games should be played on the scheduled date.

Rules are the same as League games except for:

Weather affected games:

Games should be decided on the appointed day, if possible, either by playing a reduced game, having a bowl out, or tossing a coin. Forfeitures are not encouraged but are acceptable as a last resort.

Where both sides are in agreement one re-arrangement of the tie is permitted. A result **MUST** then be achieved at that time.

Abandoned fixtures: the fixtures secretary will hold a lottery to decide the winner.

Tied game:

Winner decided by the following priority

- i) team losing least wickets wins
- ii) highest total after 6 overs.
- iii) most runs from the bat
- iv) if still equal decide by bowl out
- v) if unable, decide by toss of a coin.

Audrey Burley 10x10 Cup

Teams knocked out in the first round will enter the Plate competition.

All fixtures are to be played as advertised. Wednesday league rules should be adopted where appropriate, except for:

Rules for 10 x 10 Competitions:

All ten fielders will bowl one six ball over
The wicket keeper cannot bowl
Wides/no balls count as 4 extras and are NOT re-bowled (except last over)
In the **last** over wides/no balls still count 4 but must also be re-bowled
Extra runs can be scored off wides and no balls as per normal laws of cricket
Bowlers run ups are limited to 8 paces
Fielding circles are used as per League rules
Batsmen retire "out" once they reach 20 runs

Less than 10 outfielders: Umpire shall hold a ballot to decide which player(s) bowls the

extra over(s).

Player injured: Umpire holds ballot to complete remaining balls/overs.

Ties should be decided using Cup Rule 58.

Howard Burley Challenge Cup

A new knockout cup involving all teams. Played over 12x8 ball overs with standard League rules (wides rebowled and free hit for no-balls).

Nic Harvey Challenge Cup

Another new knockout cup involving all teams eliminated in round one of the Howard Burley cup. Played over 12x8 ball overs with standard League rules (as above).

Rules for Dave Stubley W60

Teams knocked out in the first round will enter the Plate competition.

Rules are based on the Hundred.

Innings are 60 balls each. Whoever scores the most runs wins.

The fielding side change ends after 10 balls. Bowlers deliver either 5 or 10 consecutive balls. The captain decides.

Each bowler can deliver a maximum of 10 legal balls.

There are no powerplays but fielding circles apply.

Wides and no-balls score 1 and are rebowled

No-balls result in a free hit

DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURES

The League will adopt the new ECB General Conduct Regulations for Recreational Cricket, applied and interpreted appropriately for our League.

All players and club officials must abide by League disciplinary procedures.

Captains and umpires together are expected to set the tone for the match.

The League expects the highest possible standards from all players.

Umpires will report any breach of discipline to the League who will assess the offence and may call a disciplinary hearing.

The League will provide the strongest possible backing to umpires

Disciplinary Hearings

Any persons summoned to a disciplinary hearing can familiarise themselves with procedures by reading the full text on the League website.

If anyone is found guilty of an offence the League are mandated to report it to the WCB and their punishment can be expected to be enforced countrywide by ECB.

Umpire appointments for all fixtures are published at the start of the season. Home teams are responsible for notifying umpires of any changes (e.g. cancellations) to fixtures. Umpire contact details are listed separately in this publication. Changes to umpire appointments will be notified to the home team by the League Umpire Appointments secretary.

Umpires fees for 2024

Umpires should be paid their fee before the start of the game. Failure to pay umpires fees shall initiate a £25.00 fine. Both teams are responsible for paying umpires. Fees are payable for all Cup and League matches including Finals.

Two umpires in attendance	£16.00 each umpire
Cancelled match	£5.00 each umpire
If travelling more than 7 miles from home	£8.00 each umpire
Only one umpire in attendance	£24.00 (£12.00 by each team)
Cancelled match	£5.00
If travelling more than 7 miles from home	£8.00

Umpires

- Should arrive 15 minutes before start
- Only one umpire present: batting side shall operate Square Leg only
- No umpires present: captains nominate both umpires from the persons available
- Non-attendance or late arrival of umpires should be reported to the League

Team sheet and umpire liability card

- The home team should provide the team sheet.
- Both captains should enter their teams for the match **BEFORE THE TOSS**.
- Identify all under 19s and sign the disclaimer on the back.
- Hand to the umpires for their inspection at the toss.
- Cards should be retained by the home captain and forwarded to the League.
- If teams are unwilling to sign the card umpires have the right to refuse to stand.

Any person signing this card should be aware that liability effectively transfers to them. For this reason it is imperative that the signatory is a fully paid up member of the club and that the club insurance is adequate to cover the situation.

Match Referee

The League's official match referee may appear at any game to support the umpires and enforce League rules where necessary. He has the full support of the League and his decisions should be respected.



UMPIRES PANEL 2024

The League Umpire Appointment's Secretary is Drew Manterfield (Tel: 07935 976552). Umpire appointments will be made at the start of the season based on umpire availability. All clubs will receive notification of umpire appointments and they will be posted on the League website.

Umpires who find they cannot fulfil their allocated fixture on or near the day concerned will contact the League Umpire Appointment's Secretary who will reallocate umpires accordingly and inform the home club using the contacts list in this publication, giving as much notice as possible.

Cancelled fixtures: Home teams must inform the appointed umpire by 5.00pm on the match day if the fixture is cancelled or rescheduled.

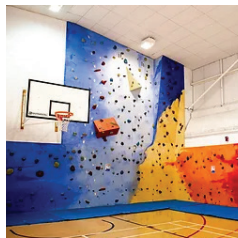
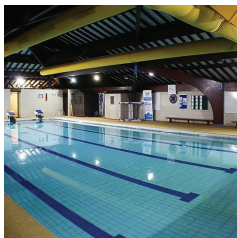
